International Students Admission Guide



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Yanshan University is one of national key universities. It is the major university supported by Hebei Province in the development of national first-class university and world first-class disciplines. YSU is a member of the Cooperation Consortium of Beijing High Technology Universities. Yanshan University, as an institution of Northeast Heavy Machinery Institute under the administration of the former Ministry of Machinery Industry, grew out of the renowned Harbin Institute of Technology. In 1978, it was identified as a national key institution of higher education. From 1985 to 1997, it had moved to Qinhuangdao City, and acquired its current name Yanshan University (YSU).

YSU offers 12 postdoctoral research programs and confers doctorates in 14 first-level disciplines and in 3 professional doctoral programs. YSU has 5 national key disciplines, and 16 provincial key disciplines. YSU's specialties of engineering, materials science, chemistry, and computer science, environmental science and ecology have recently been ranked in the ESI's top 1%.

YSU has built various State key laboratories and research platforms, including the State Key Laboratory of Metastable Materials Science and Technology, the National Engineering Research Center for Equipment and Technology of Cold Rolled Strip, the National-Local Joint Engineering Research Center for Advanced Manufacturing, Forming Technology, and Equipment under Extreme Conditions.

YSU has 3 Academicians of Chinese Academy of Sciences, 2 academicians of CAE Member, 7 distinguished professors from the Ten-thousand Talents Program, 17 professors from the

Changjiang Scholars Program, and 27 recipients of the China National Funds for Distinguished Young Scientists.

YSU values and promotes the opening-up of education to the outside world and builds a global network of international exchanges. The university has established cooperative relationships with over 100 high-level universities and scientific research institutions in more than 30 countries and regions to carry out a wide range of programs such as joint education, teacher exchanges and scientific research. In support of China's Belt and Road Initiative, YSU implements an international development strategy and is committed to cultivating talents with global perspectives and competitiveness in order to improve the university's international influence and its level of educational opening-up.

Qinhuangdao City, Hebei Province, where Yanshan University is located, is a national historical and cultural city. Qinhuangdao City has long been known as summer resort. It is "a city in the forest" or "forest in the city" and enjoys a reputation for its scenic beauty with green lands and blue waters.

Entrance Examination

1. Students of Preparatory and Advanced-study programs shall take Chinese language test, based on which the levels of study programs are determined.
2. Chinese taught students need attend Chinese culture examination and English taught students need attend English examination.
3. All new students need attend psychological test.

Eligibility

1. Basic Requirements

Applicants must be physically and mentally healthy, without medical history of infectious disease and mental disorders; Applicants must have complete educational and working experiences, without criminal records; Applicants genuinely intend to study Chinese history and cultures, respect Chinese customs, and abide by the laws and regulations of the Chinese government as well as the rules and regulations of the University.

2. Identity Verification

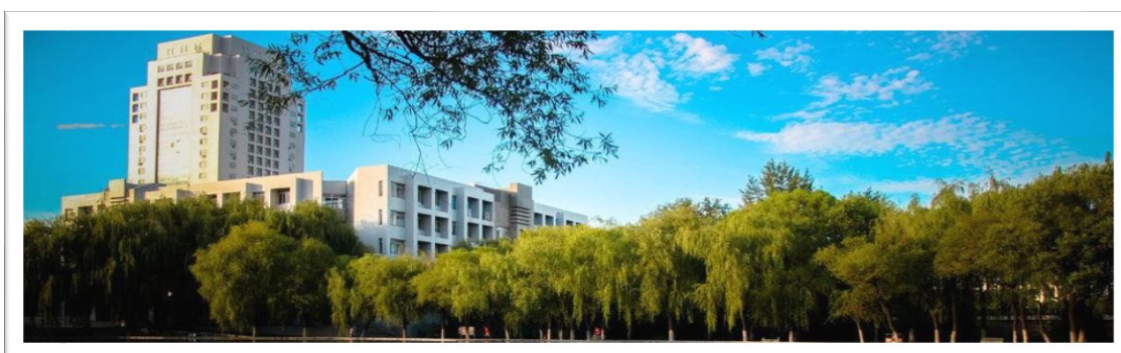
Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens with a valid passport.

Applicants who were Chinese citizens and then emigrated to other countries and acquired nationality should hold the non-Chinese passport for 4 years and above, and have records of actual residence at least for 2 years (9 months actual residence can be calculated as one year, subject to the exit/ entry records) outside of China in the last 4 years (by April 30 of the enrollment year).

The admission only starts after the verification of applicant's documents by Exist-Entry Administration Bureau of Qinhuangdao Public Security Bureau.

Evidence of Financial Support

International students applying for admission shall provide fund evidence or personal bank statement (\$5,000 USD above, if parents are sponsors, a proof of relationship is required). The University shall review and evaluate the fund evidence in accordance with the principles and prudence.



Procedures:

- (1) Log in the online application system at <https://admission.yzu.edu.cn>, and upload all the HD scanned version of the documents required. Images captured by mobile phone or camera and copies are not acceptable.
- (2) Pay the application fee, and upload the scanned version of bank receipt to application system. The application fee is non-refundable.
- (3) The enrollment for degree programs is provided in the Fall Semester (generally September), for Preparatory programs provided in Spring and Fall semesters (March and September). Guarantee all the information and application documents submitted in this application are authentic, accurate, and complete, otherwise the application will not be processed or declined, and applicants bear the consequences.

- (3) Passport copies (photograph page), passport is not renewable from the time of application to the entry to China with a valid visa.
- (4) Student Identity Certification or graduation certificate copies (non-Chinese or English versions must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations).
- (5) Copies of high school transcripts (non-Chinese or English versions must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations).

- (6) Copies of valid New HSK-3 certificate.
- (7) Police Certificate (non-school students shall provide Police Certificate. - (2) Physical Examination Record for Foreigner (by the admission, the certificate must be less than six months old).
- (3) Passport copies (photograph page), passport is not renewable from the time of application to the entry to China with a valid visa.
- (4) Student Identity Certification or graduation certificate copies (non-Chinese or English versions must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations).
- (5) Copies of high school transcripts (non-Chinese or English versions must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations).
- (6) Copies of language proficiency certificate (valid New HSK-4 for Chinese medium programs and valid English language proficiency certificate for English medium programs are required).
- (7) Recommendation letters from two course teachers.
- (8) Police Certificate (non-school students shall provide Police Certificate. The certificate should be less than six months old, if valid date is unspecified; If the validity period is indicated, the materials shall prevail; Students enrolled shall provide a proof of school/university performance instead).
- (9) Personal bank statement as evidence of financial support (\$5,000 USD above, evidence of relationship must be provided in the case of parents being sponsors).
- (10) Registration fee CNY 600 (The scanned copy of the bank receipt needs to be uploaded to online application system).

4. Master's program

- (1) Complete the online registration system <https://admission.yzu.edu.cn> (with photos) and generate the application form. Note: A description of your complete and consecutive educational or working experiences from junior middle school to the highest education qualification must be provided.
- (2) Physical Examination Record for Foreigner (by the admission, the certificate must be less than six months old).
- (3) Passport copies (photograph page), passport is not renewable from the time of application to the entry to China with a valid visa.
- (4) Student Identity Certification or graduation certificate copies (non-Chinese or English versions must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations).
- (5) Copies of university transcripts (non-Chinese or English versions must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations).

(6) Copies of language proficiency certificate (valid New HSK-4 for Chinese medium programs and valid English language proficiency certificate for English medium programs are required).

(7) Personal statement.

(8) Recommendation letters from two professors (above the academic title of associate professorship).

(9) Police Certificate (non-university student shall provide Police Certificate. The certificate should be less than six months old, if valid date is unspecified; If the validity period is indicated, the materials shall prevail; Students enrolled shall provide a proof of school/university performance instead).

(10) Personal bank statement as evidence of financial support (\$5,000 USD above, evidence of relationship must be provided in the case of parents being sponsors; Eligible scholarship applicants are not required to submit this proof).

(11) Registration fee CNY 800 (The scanned copy of the bank receipt needs to be uploaded to online application system).

5. Doctoral program

(1) Complete the online registration system <https://admission.ysu.edu.cn> (with photos) and generate the application form. Note: A description of your complete and consecutive educational or working experiences from junior middle school to the highest education qualification must be provided.

(2) Physical Examination Record for Foreigner (by the admission, the certificate must be less than six months old).

(3) Passport copies (photograph page), passport is not renewable from the time of application to the entry to China with a valid visa.

(4) Student Identity Certification or graduation certificate copies (non-Chinese or English versions must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations).

(5) Copies of postgraduate transcripts (non-Chinese or English versions must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations).

(6) Copies of language proficiency certificate (valid New HSK-4 for Chinese medium programs and valid English language proficiency certificate for English medium programs are required).

(7) Personal statement.

(8) Recommendation letters from two professors (above the academic title of associate professorship).

(9) Police Certificate (non-university students shall provide Police Certificate. The certificate should be less than six months old, if valid date is unspecified; If the validity period is indicated, the materials shall prevail; Students enrolled shall provide a proof of school/university performance instead).

(10) Personal bank statement as evidence of financial support (\$5,000 USD above, evidence of relationship must be provided in the case of parents being sponsors; Eligible scholarship applicants are not required to submit this proof).

(11) Registration fee CNY 800 (The scanned copy of the bank receipt needs to be uploaded to online application system).

Admission Procedure and Registration

- (1) YSU international student admission committee will review and evaluate applications of international students in accordance with the relevant procedures and regulations. The Admission Office will decide on the final admission list based on the comprehensive review and preliminary examination by the Department/School. The admission list will be publicized. After the publicity, YSU School of International Education will send to the successful candidates and admission notice.
- (2) The admission work shall be filed into archives and managed properly.
- (3) The Admission Notice and Visa Application Form (JW202 or JW201) shall be issued after the documents verification.
- (4) Applicants with Admission Notice shall provide Admission Notice, Visa Application Form, Physical Examination Record for Foreigner, and Blood Test Report (all in original) to the local Chinese Embassy for Chinese student visa application (X visa).
- (5) The applicants admitted shall complete the enrollment on the date specified in the Admission Notice with the original application materials. If applicants cannot enroll as suggested, they should inform the School of International Education in advance, otherwise they will be disqualified from admission.

Fee Policy

(2) Fees and Refund Policy

The fees policy was made in accordance with the relevant regulations of the Ministry of Education and the standards approved by the Hebei Provincial Price Management Department. All fees are counted in CNY.

The international students who discontinue the study can apply to the School for permission. The refund application shall be processed in accordance with the "Yanshan University Expense Regulations for International Students".

1. National Scholarship

(1) Chinese government scholarship: www.campuschina.org

1) Bilateral Program (Type A)

The program accords with the cooperation and exchange agreements or consensus reached by the Chinese government and the governments and institutions of other nations. It is open to undergraduates, postgraduates, general and senior scholars.

An applicant shall file an application with the dispatching department of their home countries.

2) University Program (Type B, the agency number of Yanshan University is 10216)

The universities independently select and recommend master's and doctoral candidates, and finally the China Scholarship Council(CSC) determines the admission candidates.

2. Hebei Provincial Government Scholarship

Hebei provincial government scholarship was established with the aims to enhance the development of excellent international students of undergraduate degree programs or above in Hebei Province. At the end of each year, a comprehensive evaluation will be conducted for eligible international students. The evaluation and distribution of scholarships will be carried out in accordance with the relevant regulations of the state and university.

3. YSU President Scholarship

YSU President Scholarship is established to support self-funded international students, including doctoral students, master's students, and undergraduate students. Chinese government scholarship holders and international Chinese teacher scholarship holders are not eligible for the YSU President Scholarship application. According to the Yanshan University Measures on Annual Reviews of President Scholarship for International Students, at the end of each academic year, the performance of scholarship students will be comprehensively assessed, and according to the review results, whether to continue to receive scholarships.

(2) Eligibility

Applicants must meet the basic requirements of Yanshan University for international students. Applicants must be friendly to China, have good academic performance, strictly abide by Chinese laws, social ethics, and rules and regulations of Yanshan University, have good overall qualities, and maintain high ethical standards. The specific requirements are as follows:

★ To apply for the scholarship for Undergraduate students, applicants must meet at least one of the

following requirements, and those with multiple qualifications are preferred.

- 1) Applicants for Chinese medium programs must obtain a certificate of HSK level 5 or above; for English medium programs, IELTS scores of 6.5 or above, TOEFL scores of 85 or above, Duolingo scores of 105 or above, or the equivalent English proficiency and above;
- 2) Participated in competitions at school/university level and above and won awards;
- 3) High school grades average is above 75;
- 4) Talents or expertise certified by a national professional association.

★ To apply for the scholarship for Master's students, applicants must meet at least one of the following requirements, and those with multiple qualifications are preferred.

- 1) The average academic achievement of undergraduate study is above 80;
- 2) Bachelor's degree thesis rated with good result or above;
- 3) Applicants for Chinese medium programs must obtain a certificate of HSK level 5 or above; for English medium programs, IELTS scores of 6.5 or above, TOEFL scores of 85 or above, Duolingo scores of 105 or above, or the equivalent English proficiency and above;
- 4) Published works or articles being the first author or corresponding author in accredited publications of the home country or China.

★ To apply for the scholarship for Doctoral students, applicants must meet at least one of the following requirements, and those with multiple qualifications are preferred.

- 1) The average academic achievement of master's study is above 80;
- 2) Master's degree thesis rated with good result or above;
- 3) Applicants for Chinese medium programs must obtain a certificate of HSK level 5 or above; for English medium programs, IELTS scores of 6.5 or above, TOEFL scores of 85 or above, Duolingo scores of 105 or above, or the equivalent English proficiency and above;
- 4) Published high-level academic papers being the first author or corresponding author in academic journals.

(3) Application procedures

1) Log in the online application system <https://admission.ysu.edu.cn> to complete application online and submit the following materials:

- YSU President Scholarship Application Form;
- Notarized highest education/degree certificate. If the applicant is a student at school/university or is already employed, he/she must also submit an enrollment certificate issued by the institution or employment certificate provided by the employer. Non-Chinese or English versions must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.
- Academic transcripts. Non-Chinese or English versions must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.
- The HD scanned version of original language proficiency certificate.
- The HD scanned version of original competition and contest awards.
- The HD scanned version of original works or articles published in academic journals.
- The HD scanned version of supporting original documents of talents or expertise certified by a national professional association.
- Other supporting materials.

Note: The originals of the above materials need to be reviewed and verified at enrollment

- 2) The School of International Education will review and verify the applications, and forward the eligible applications to the YSU President Scholarship committee for evaluation. The committee is composed of members of the YSU International Student Admission Group.
- 3) The YSU President Scholarship committee will propose the list of winners based on review of the School's comments and applicant's materials (applicant interview can be organized when necessary).
- 4) The nomination list will be posted and publicized on the relevant websites for seven working days. After the publicity, if there are no objections, YSU School of International Education will inform the successful candidates of the result with written notification.
- 5) International students who have received scholarships shall go through the registration procedures before the date specified by the School, otherwise they will be treated as automatically waiving scholarships.



1. Study Duration

A flexible academic system is adopted for international students in China. The study duration for undergraduate international students can be extended to 6 years (including suspension and demotion) based on the standard 4-year academic system; the standard academic system for master's degree is 3 years, and maximum duration is 4 years (including suspension); the standard academic system for doctoral degree is 4 years, and maximum duration is 6 years (including suspension). International students are exempt from paying tuition during the period of suspension and military service.

2. Academic Regulation

The credit system is adopted in undergraduate programs. International student shall complete the courses of curriculum as required by the University. In principle, international students shall attend the courses with Chinese students of the same specialty except for the class-based programs. The courses for undergraduate students are divided into required courses and elective courses. The courses selected in each semester must meet the credit requirements specified in the curriculum plan. International students complete the course selection procedures online in the Academic Affairs Management system. Master's and doctoral students should complete the courses and their dissertations under the guidance of their supervisors in accordance with the curriculum formulated at the time of admission.

3. Graduation and Degree Awarding

Undergraduate students who have completed all the requirements stipulated in the academic plan are permitted to graduate, and the graduation certificate will be conferred.

Master's students who have completed all the requirements stipulated in the academic plan and passed their thesis defense upon completion of their study are permitted to graduate, and the graduation certificate will be conferred.

According to the "Regulations on Degree of the People's Republic of China", the eligible undergraduate, master's, and doctoral graduates will be awarded bachelor, master and doctorate degrees respectively.

4. Change of Student Status

International students who apply for suspension, transfer, withdrawal, change of study program, change of student category, extension, or early completion of studies should apply to the School of International Education and go through relevant procedures after obtaining approval.

1. Medical Insurance

The Ministry of Education of China stipulates that all international students must be medically insured throughout their entire planned period of study. Students are required to purchase the Comprehensive Insurance Plan of Foreign Students to ensure that international students in China receive insurance coverage, and provide necessary insurance business assistance.

Insurance premium: CNY400/half a year; CNY 800/ year; insurance coverage: medical insurance and accident insurance.

Students who do not have valid medical insurance will not be allowed to register; those who have already studied at the University shall be disqualified and withdrawn from the University.

2. Accommodation Information

The University provide dormitory for international students. Unified accommodation management is adopted. Each room is equipped with independent toilet, 24-hour hot water shower, air conditioning, refrigerator, microwave oven, TV, wireless network and other facilities; each floor is equipped with a common kitchen and communal automatic washing machine.

3. Dining Information

There are many dining places on west campus, including Yanyuan Restaurant and Darongshu Restaurant. The canteen provides a variety of local snacks, where students can enjoy the rich and delicious food. There is a Muslim restaurant on the first floor of the canteen on the west campus.

4. University Transportation

There is a commuter bus on campus, and the cost of each ride is 1 yuan. The buses commute between the starting point of the Yanda Hotel Station on the East Campus, and the ending point of the School of Art and Design on the West Campus. First train at 6:30, last train at 22:30.

5. Bank, Supermarket, Post Office

There are 24-hour self-service banking services, postal and communication service centers on the first floor of the canteen on the west campus. It is convenient for students to withdraw money, buy mobile phones or phone cards, and mail parcels. The Guangyuan Supermarket on the West Campus has a wide range of daily necessities. The above facilities are within 500 meters of the international student dormitory, providing convenient living services for students.

6. Clubs and Societies

International students can participate in a wide range of student clubs and societies established in the University or Schools; there are various sports events such as school sports games, football leagues, basketball matches; the annual International Cultural Festival provides international students with the opportunity to show their home country's cultural customs and promote their relationship with China; the international student Chinese language contests at all levels, including the Chinese Talent Competition, Debate Competition, and Opera Competition, provide a platform for international students to show their talents and Chinese language skills.

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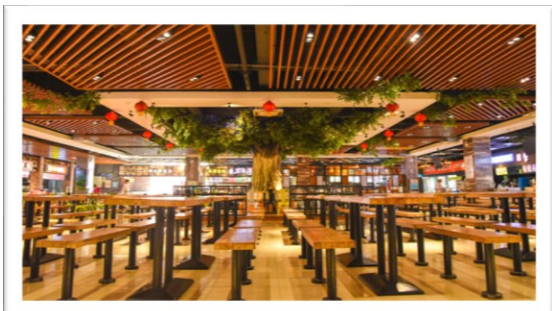
